## Wellsoft v10 Live – Nebraska Medical Center Campuses

Ready, set, go! Wellsoft set a record recently at Nebraska Medical Center as 3 separate Emergency Departments went live simultaneously.

Prior to opening a new, combined state-of-the-art Emergency Department, the downtown University and Clarkson Towers, along with the Clarkson West Medical Center all went live together.

The Wellsoft team, led by Howard Engleman and Michael Klein, staffed all three Emergency Departments during

go-live, with support from Nebraska super-users.

About 6 weeks later the two downtown Emergency Departments were united in a beautiful, new 20,000 square foot, 33 bed department.

Wellsoft v10 patient tracking, triage, discharge planning, orders tracking, results reporting, drug/drug and drug/allergy checking and report generation were all implemented in Phase 1.

Phase 2 implementation, including nursing and physician documentation, is now underway.

The Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha treats 60,000 patients from across the region and has been recognized for service excellence by the 2005 J.D. Power and Associates Distinguished Hospital Program.

As with all Wellsoft EDIS features, the dashboard is custom configured to ensure that Wellsoft works for you!

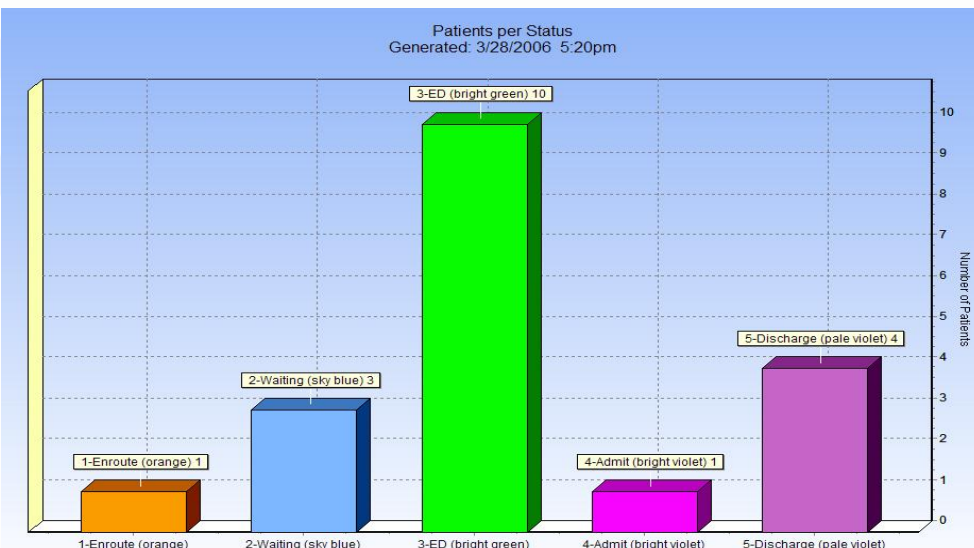
### Report Training Classes Begin

## Enhanced Audit Feature Now Includes Reporting

With security and patient privacy concerns firmly at the top of many hospital agendas, Wellsoft has designed an enhanced audit module.

Wellsoft v10 can now audit all access to a patient record in addition to tracking any changes to that patient record.

The new feature enables Wellsoft v10 to log all audited events to a security restricted module. Information in this database can be queried using the Wellsoft report writer.

Audited events include:

- Access to Record Displays, Editor Displays, Printing, and the "Find Function".

- Changes to Fields.
- Addition and Deletion of Records.
- Manual Merging of Records.

Every entry can be set to automatically include data such as the Event Date/Time, User Name and ID, Workstation ID, Module Name and ID, Internal Record ID, Record ID, Patient ID, Record Main Field, Event Type, Event Location ID, Event Location Description and new values.

This new module greatly enhances audit capabilities within Wellsoft v10 both from an access monitoring and reporting perspective.

## Reporting Q & A

Did you know that:

- ◆ TODAY and NOW can be used in the date range field as an alternative to entering a specific date (1/1/06).
- ◆ Also "TODAY-1" can be used for yesterday and "TODAY-7" for the past week.
- ◆ If you take a screen shot of report settings (ALT + PRINTSCREEN then paste to a document) before making changes to a report format, it can be used as a reference if you decide to re-set it back to its original format.

## Integrated PACS link at Hamilton Medical Center

Make that a first for Wellsoft and Hamilton Medical Center: a new integrated link to the GE Centricity Web PACS has been established in Wellsoft v10.

Physicians simply click on the patient name on the Wellsoft tracking display and then on the PACS link button, and the patient's films are instantly displayed. No need to search for the patient or the particular date.

Films for patients no longer in the department are easily accessed the same way by clicking on the name in the patient directory and then on the PACS link.

Physicians use 2 GE clinical workstations with high resolution Barco PACS monitors to view the images. Hamilton has co-located these displays in the physician work areas to enhance efficiency.

According to Kim Brown, Clinical IS Liaison at Hamilton, "The doctors really like being able to pull up films right from the tracking display. They're happy to do it the easy way!"
