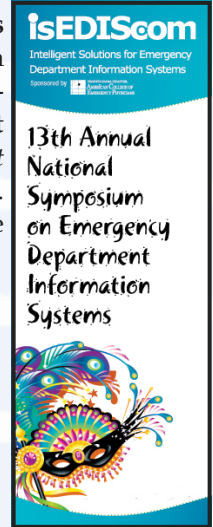

New Patient Tracking Features

Patient Entry Kiosk/Display - The Wellsoft Patient Entry Display will allow patients to enter their own names, chief complaint, sex and age into the Wellsoft application through a user friendly graphical interface. Entering their names will populate the triage track with their information once processed.

Split Screen— Use multiple copies of Wellsoft EDIS on one display. Each Split Screen (or quadrant) View is interactive and can be configured to display information independently, depending on the needs of the user.

Unoccupied Room Tracking View— display both occupied or unoccupied (empty) rooms together directly on the Patient Tracking Display. This feature may be configured within your current sort and filter menu.
